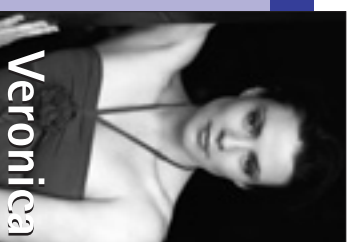

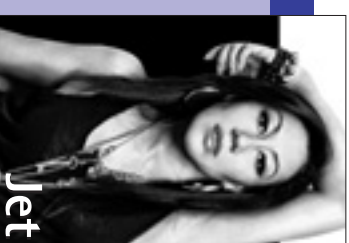

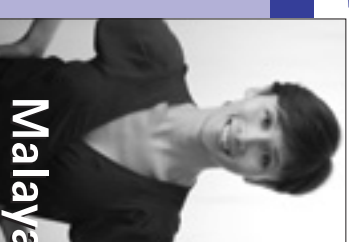

## Prizes & awards

### ADVANCED LEVEL

**• AMERICAN JAZZ DANCE AFFILIATION DIRECTORS AWARD**

### INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

**• MARY EVERS SCHOLARSHIP** – This is a monetary award to the value of \$500.00 and is given in memory of Mary Evers who was the founder of the American Jazz Dance Affiliation. One awarded in each centre.  
**• SIX Return Scholarships** for 2012 event.

### BEGINNER LEVEL

**• \$200 cash.** One awarded in each centre.

## Registration

- EARLY REGISTRATION:** By posting your registration BEFORE the cut-off-date a discounted fee applies.
- Late registration and on the day payments are available.
- Students must be over 9 years of age.
- Assistant Teachers must be over 16 years of age.
- One-day registration is available on the first day of the workshop only.
- For security purposes observer passes are required. Pre-registered observers will receive a free pass by applying with a registration form giving full name. This entitles attendance to any class (except Teachers Only) and participation in a special class for observers only. A late and on the day registration fee will apply.
- Discounts for studio groups apply.
- All dancers must wear ID bands at all times. The band must be intact. Replacements will incur a charge.
- Students under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Phoenix management reserve the right to refuse service to any individual.
- Confirmation of receipt of registration will be posted within 7 working days.
- Recording of choreography or performances at the event site is not permitted. Copyright laws prohibit the use of video or similar recording devices.

**DANCE WITH THE STARS** – This is a fabulous chance for dancers to perform with the faculty. Dancers are chosen during the second day of workshops to perform at the award ceremony.

**AWARDS REGISTRATION** – Students wishing to be considered for any of the above awards must be registered before Sunday. Go to the desk after 2pm on Saturday to receive your number. Teachers are requested to enter group lists before 10.30am Saturday for ease of administration. Students will be required to wear numbers all day on Sunday.

**CLASS LEVELS** – Three levels of workshops will run simultaneously at the event. To help in selecting a suitable level the following is a guide.  
**BEGINNERS** single pirouettes, jete, pas de bourree, basic rhythm steps.  
**INTERMEDIATE** double pirouettes, chaine, pique, grande jete etc.  
**ADVANCED** triple turns, advanced jumps, fast tempo technique.

**TEACHER AND ASSISTANTS** this registration allows entry to any class and any closed teacher only workshops.

### CATERING

- Cafeteria facilities will be available at venues.
- To ease congestion at the cafe teacher groups are asked to take advantage of the pre-packed lunch orders available. Forms are available with registration confirmation.

## Important Notes

- Phoenix International Dance Workshop reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
